Dear Lower Township Families,

Thank you for supporting your children during this fully virtual period. We know it was a difficult task to adjust everyone's schedule, but this was a necessary measure to keep everyone safe. On **Monday, January 4th** we will all return for another week of *virtual instruction*. Beginning **Monday, January 11th** we will be back in school for *in-person instruction*. We will follow our early dismissal schedule of 4 days of in-person instruction with Wednesday remaining a virtual day. We are excited to welcome everyone back because we know this is the best educational setting.

Thank you to all who have been doing an exceptional job following the guidelines. We need everyone to continue this practice so we can keep our doors open. In addition to checking for symptoms we are also asking families to submit a mandatory electronic screening form for each child. A link will be sent via text every morning or you can find the link on our website. If your child/children display any symptoms from the screening list please do not send them to school.

Families should also follow the state guidelines if traveling outside of NJ:

- **If travel is unavoidable, travelers should consider getting tested with a viral test (not an antibody test) 1-3 days before the trip and again 3-5 days after the trip.**
- **If travelers test positive, they should self-isolate for at least 10 days and should postpone travel during that time.**
- **If travelers test negative, they should quarantine for a full 7 days after travel.**
- **If testing is not available (or if the results are delayed), travelers should quarantine for 10 days after travel.**

We will be able to better meet the needs of your child/children if you follow our health precautions and submit a daily student screening.
