Notice is hereby given that pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20, New Jersey Pay to Play, and other legislative enactments, more specifically Chapter 271 of the laws of the State of New Jersey, the Lower Township Board of Education located at 905 Seashore Road, Cape May, NJ 08204 is seeking RFQs for professional services to be provided to the Lower Township Board of Education as listed below for the period July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027.

The qualifications submitted for professional services contracts should address and will be evaluated on the basis of:

- Experience and reputation in the field.
- Knowledge of the Lower Township Elementary School District.

Specialized services required - The selected solicitor will be expected to provide specialized professional services to the Board of Education during the entire year on an as needed basis and to be available to provide advice to the Board of Education during non-business hours including the attendance at the monthly Board of Education meetings.

School Auditor:

Scope of Services:

The Board of Education desires to appoint a firm of certified public accountants to act as board auditors for the Lower Township School District Board of Education. Applicant should demonstrate knowledge of board of education auditing laws and regulations and experience in providing advice to boards of education on records compliance issues. Please outline the fee for the completion of the statutory audit, and a separate fee to review the ASSA.

Minimum Qualifications:

- A minimum of 25 years' experience in New Jersey school accounting/audits and be properly credentialed as a licensed public school accountant. Proposers must also be able to provide its most recent peer/quality report performed in accordance with N.J.A.C 6A:23A-16.2(i)(1).

- A minimum of three members dedicated to complete audit in a timely manner and must demonstrate a track record of such.

2. Consultation to school district medical staff regarding the delivery of school health services, which includes special health care needs and technology supported and medically fragile children, including those covered by 20 U.S.C. 1400 et seq, Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act.
3. Consultation to the District Board of Education, school district administrators and staff as needed.
4. Physical examinations conducted in the school physician's office or other comparably equipped facility for students who do not have a medical home or whose parent has identified the school as the medical home for the purpose of sports physical examination.

Applicant should demonstrate knowledge of municipal bond and finance law. Any experience or knowledge of matters that directly affect the Board of Education should be addressed.

Risk Management Consultant (Health Insurance Broker)**Scope of Services:**

The district is seeking quotes through the EUS procurement process from a qualified Risk Management Consultants {Health Insurance Broker}. The selected Risk Management Consultant will be expected to provide specialized professional services to the Board of Education during the entire year on an as needed basis via the administration of said program, either as insured by the Southern Coastal HIF, Self-Insured, or the SHBP and specifically with a recommendation as to the most beneficial health insurance program including Health, RX and Dental for the succeeding budget year. Attend either monthly or quarterly HIF meetings, district meetings, or others as requested, and be eligible to serve as the district's risk management consultant in accordance with HIF requirements. In addition, the RMC-{Health Insurance Broker} will assist with the District's wellness program.

Minimum Qualifications:

- A minimum of 20 years' experience with self-insured health insurance, fully funded insurance programs, health Insurance Funds, (HIFS), and State Health Benefits Program (SEHBP).

Specialized services required - The selected financial advisor will be expected to provide specialized professional services to the Board of Education during the entire year on an as needed basis, and will be available to provide advice to the Board of Education during non business hours.

Minimum Qualifications

- The firm shall have at least ten (10) years of experience in representing public entities.
- The firm shall designate one professional within the firm who will be assigned to represent the interest of the School District. This individual shall have been admitted and/or licensed in his/her profession and be in good standing.
- The firm will be the district's Continuing Disclosure Agent and Municipal Advisor of Record.
- Will work in concert with the district's Auditor and bond Counsel to assist in complying with filing obligations.
- Will be a resource concerning issuance of municipal debt.

Child Study Team Services:

The billing process will be prescribed by the Lower Township Board office and require the bill to be totaled for each service rendered by the school serviced.

Nursing Services:

Scope of Services:

The Lower Township School District Board of Education is seeking a home health care agency to provide professional nursing services for students in grades PreK-6. The selected agency will be expected to provide nursing service for the district, as needed, throughout the 2026-2027 school year.

Licensing Requirements and Minimum Requirements:

The nurse supplied by the agency shall be a Registered Nurse (RN) who shall hold a current license, registration or certification to practice in the State of New Jersey and should provide services pursuant to the applicable state laws.

- NJ Licensure as Registered Nurse or Licensed Practicing Nurse
- A minimum of 3 years' experience.
- Experience dealing with children

Major Responsibility and Duties:

1. Agency should provide an RN to the district on a substitute basis.
2. The RN will provide basic nursing services to students currently attending two (2) schools located in the district.

Behavior Therapy Specialist:

Scope of Services and Minimum Requirements:

- BCBA Certification
- RBT on staff
- Provide observation of child/teacher interaction, consultation with staff, development and implementation of the Behavioral Intervention Plan with teachers as directed by the Child Study Team Supervisor.
- Define in detail all services that will be provided as a Behavior Therapy Specialist and RBT.

Pediatric Psychiatric/Neuropsychiatric Physician

Scope of Services

Provide psychiatric/neuropsychiatric evaluation reports, but not limited to:

- Typed comprehensive reports, eligibility reports reflective of the diagnosis •
Diagnostic interviews with students, parents,
teachers/caregivers/therapists/administrators
- Review of psycho-educational testing by educational diagnostician

- Debriefing (parent exit)
- All psychiatric evaluations must include eligibility report and diagnosis with functional implications in educational settings.

Minimum Requirements:

- New Jersey State Licensing
- Current Board Certification in Pediatric Psychiatry
- Seven Years of experience working with Elementary Students ages three to thirteen years.

OT/PT Services:

Scope of Services and Minimum Requirements:

- Must meet regulated licensure and/or state certification requirements.
- Implement established program goals, maintain records of assessments, consultations and evaluations
- Report writing, and maintenance of student progress reports for individual children in grades Pre-K to 6
- Position requires appropriate NJ State License and appropriate NJ School Certification, and experience working with students with disabilities.
