Dear Parent or Guardian,

The Food Service Department would like to welcome your children back to school. We are proud of our program and look forward to serving your child.

The Lower Township Board Of Education will continue to offer a free nutritious breakfast as your student enters the classroom every morning at no charge. Breakfast will be served in a unitized fashion including prepackaged whole grain cereal or whole grain muffin with crackers, fruit and or 100% fruit juice with milk and cheese stick options. Breakfast will be available during morning daycare. It is also available before and after the school bell, breakfast begins at Sandman 7:45/ Maud 8:10/ Mitnick 9:00/ Memorial 8:25. Should your student arrive late they may visit the cafeteria for breakfast upon arrival. Breakfast is available to 10:00 am at all schools. Lunches are served every day with a large variety of fruits, vegetables and whole grains.

Please complete and return the attached application as soon as possible to determine if your child is eligible to receive free or reduced meal and Summer EBT benefits. If you have more than one child in grades Pre-K through 6th, you only need to fill out one application. Please note that this year all applications must be signed and contain the last 4 digits of your social security number. If you are applying using SNAP or TANF, there must be 6 or 9 numerical digits.

Even if you do not think your child is eligible for benefits, please complete an application, they have expanded the eligibility income and other State and Federal Funded Programs are based on this information for our district.

On-line payment system is available- PAY PAMS. Pay for your child's meals on-line @ www.paypams.com. You will need your Child's Student ID #, found on your child's bus pass to set up an account.

When you create an account you no longer have to worry about handing cash to your children. Paypams access will also allow you to view purchases made in the cafeteria and increase the efficiency of the service lines.

Students are permitted to charge lunch in the event their account goes into the negative. This charge is to be paid the following day. The balance will remain on the account until paid in full. Students with outstanding charges will not be permitted to purchase snacks.
