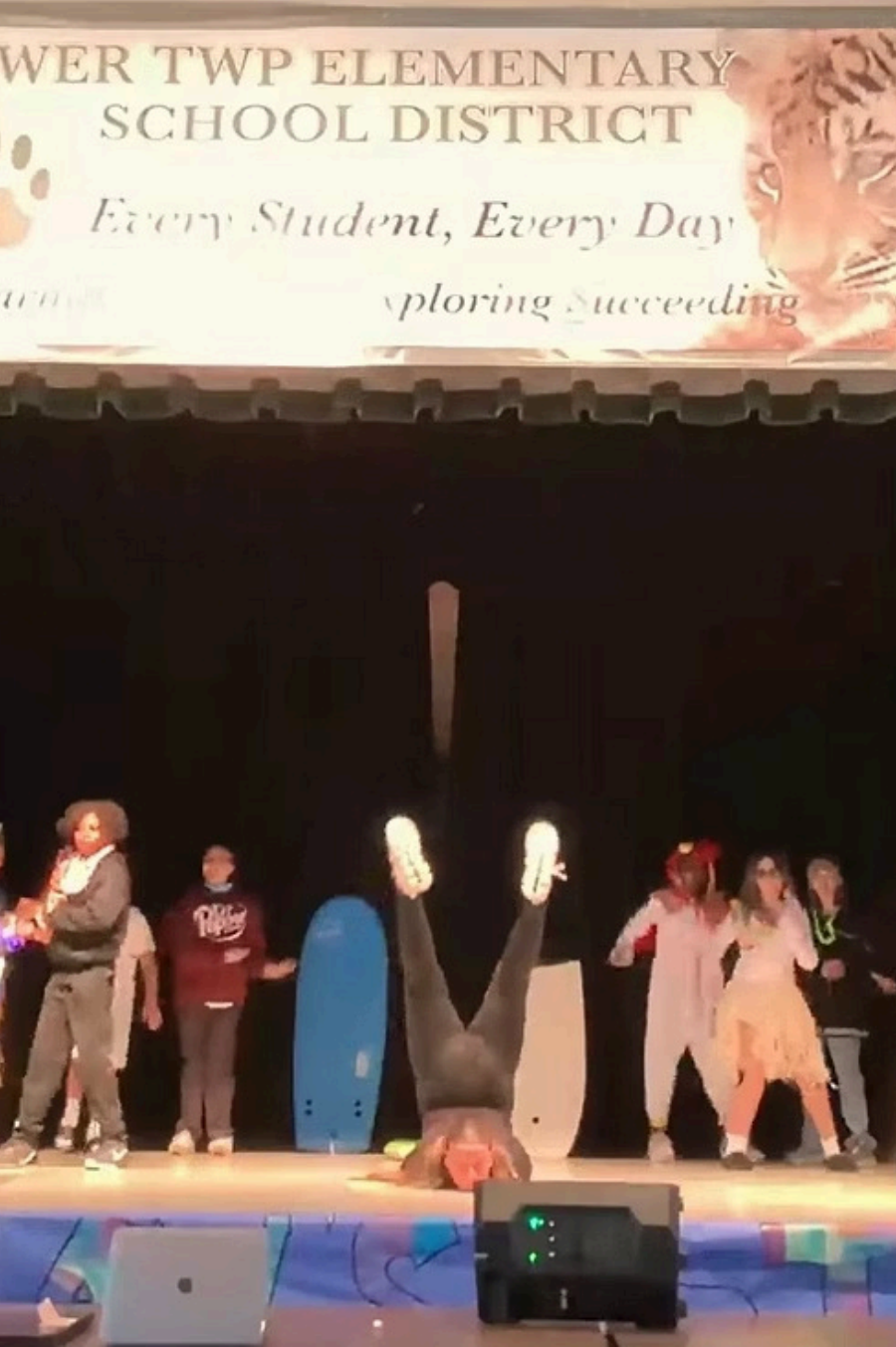
May's character trait is "Friendship."
